She has published on such subjects as Islamic mysticism and morality, and the foundations of Islamic creed from the Qur'an and the Sunna. She serves on the Transitional Arab Parliament, the Advisory and Executive Committee of the College of Islamic Studies, Qatar Foundation for Education, Science and Community Development, and the Board of Directors of the (Qatar) National Commission for Human Rights. In 2007, Egyptian President Hosni Mubarak honored Dr. Al-Mannai in recognition of her contributions to Islamic studies.
